Equitable Access to Excellent Teachers

- ▶ Experienced, effective, in-field teachers – 82% of ISD 881 teachers (51/62)
- ▶ Inexperienced teachers – 18% (11/62)
 - ▶ An inexperienced teacher is defined as a licensed teacher who has been employed for three or less years.
- ▶ Out-of-field teachers – 8% (5/62)
- ▶ No gaps have been identified in regard to equitable access of teachers for low-income students, student of color, or American Indian students.
- ▶ The district's goal is to provide every student with an effective teacher who is appropriately licensed and has a passion for teaching, excellent interpersonal skills, a solid work ethic, and excellent classroom management and instructional skills.

School Readiness

All Students Ready for Kindergarten

- ▶ At least 50% of the Maple Lake Public School kindergarten students who attend the Wee Irish Preschool program will be able to recognize over 50% of the number from 0 through 30 as measured by ESGI assessment in the first week of the 2018-2019 school year.
 - ▶ Goal not met: 42% of kindergarten students recognized at least 50% of the numbers from 0 to 30.
- ▶ At least 50% of the Maple Lake Public School kindergarten students who attend the Wee Irish Preschool program will be able to recognize all 26 uppercase letters as measured by ESGI assessment in the first week of the 2018-2019 school year.
 - ▶ Goal not met: 24% of kindergarten students recognized at least 50% of the numbers from 0 to 30.

Read Well by Third Grade

- ▶ Continuing to implement the 5 components of Reading Instruction and a Balanced Literacy approach into our core teaching in grades preK-Grade 3
- ▶ MAP testing to identify student growth
- ▶ Achievement results disaggregated to identify students who require core instruction plus additional interventions through Title I, Reading Recovery, ADSIS, etc.

All Students in Third Grade Achieving Grade Level Literacy

- ▶ The percent of all 3rd grade students enrolled in Maple Lake Elementary School on October 1, 2017 who are proficient in the reading accountability tests (MCA and MTAS) will increase from 71.4% in 2017 to 72.2% in 2018.
 - ▶ Goal not met: 69.2% were proficient.

Closing the Gap

- ▶ Working to ensure ALL students are being taught grade level standards
- ▶ Assessing JH students in core subjects to determine growth areas through MAP testing
- ▶ Provide additional reading support for JH students identified as needing interventions through MCA and MAP data

Close Identified Achievement Gaps in the District

- ▶ The proficiency gap between all students and the special education students enrolled in Maple Lake Public Schools on October 1, 2017 who are proficient in the reading accountability tests (MCA and MTAS) will decrease from 32.0% in 2017 to 30.0% in 2018.
 - ▶ Goal not met: 37.6% proficiency gap.
- ▶ The proficiency gap between all students and the free & reduced students enrolled in Maple Lake Public Schools on October 1, 2017 who are proficient in the reading accountability tests (MCA and MTAS) will decrease from 15.3% in 2017 to 13.3% in 2018.
 - ▶ Goal not met: 19.5% proficiency gap.
- ▶ The proficiency gap between all students and the special education students enrolled in Maple Lake Public Schools on October 1, 2017 who are proficient in the math accountability tests (MCA and MTAS) will decrease from 23.7% in 2017 to 21.7% in 2018.
 - ▶ Goal not met: 27.7% proficiency gap.
- ▶ The proficiency gap between all students and the free & reduced students enrolled in Maple Lake Public Schools on October 1, 2017 who are proficient in the math accountability tests (MCA and MTAS) will decrease from 9.1% in 2017 to 7.1% in 2018.
 - ▶ Goal not met: 18.2% proficiency gap.

All Students Attaining Career and College Readiness before Graduating from High School

- ▶ Maple Lake High School will have 100% of its students enrolled in 9th grade Civics courses during the third quarter complete a Career Investigation Unit and course plan, which includes a Personal Learning Plan.
 - ▶ Goal met: 100% participation
- ▶ The 80% of the Maple Lake High School juniors will take the ACT during the school day in 2018.
 - ▶ Goal not met: 67.7% took the test.
- ▶ Personal Learning Plans will be reviewed annually by 100% of the students enrolled in grades 10 and 11 at Maple Lake High School.
 - ▶ Goal met: 100% reviewed

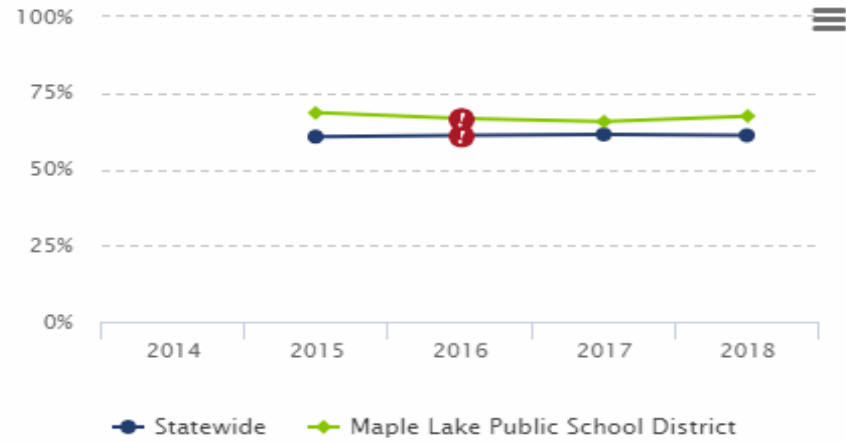
- ▶ At least 95% of Maple Lake High School seniors will graduate in four years in 2018.

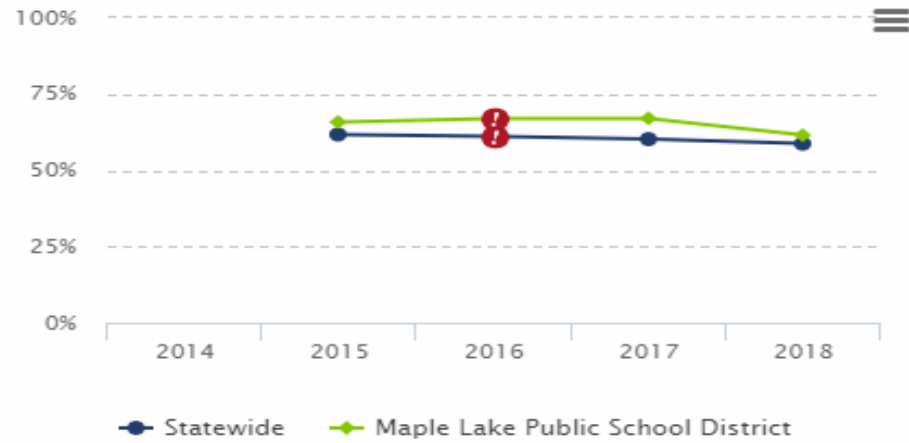

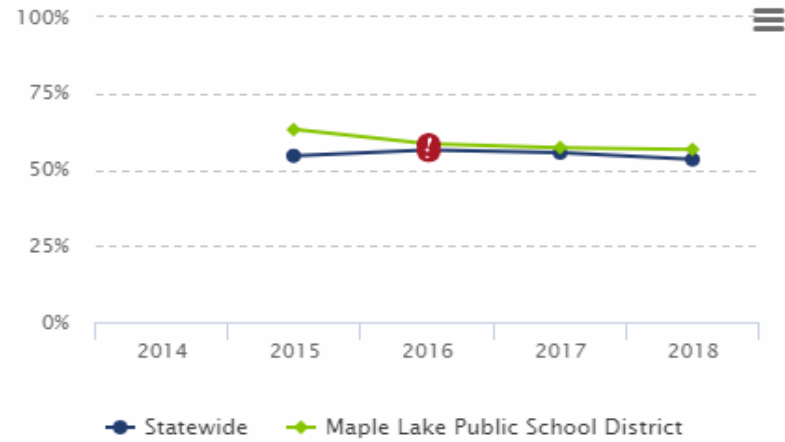

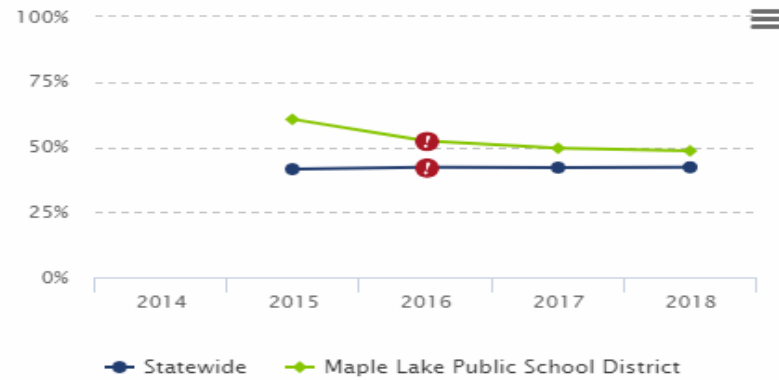

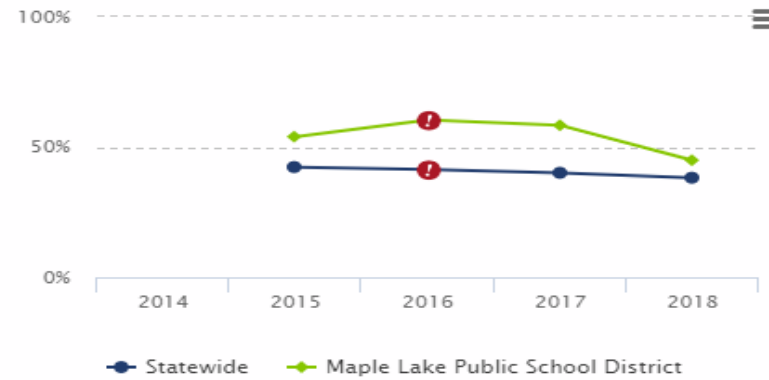

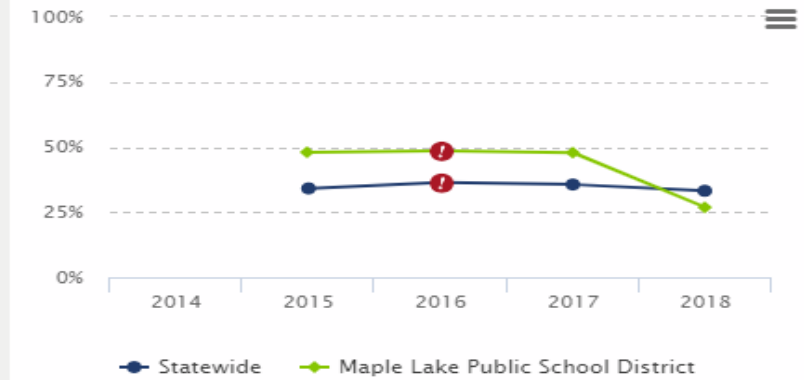

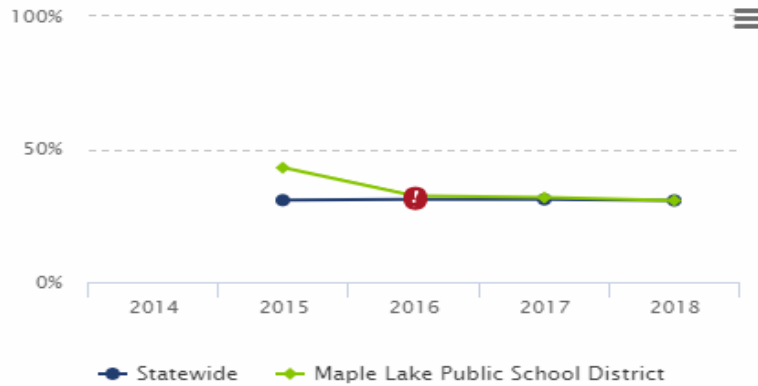

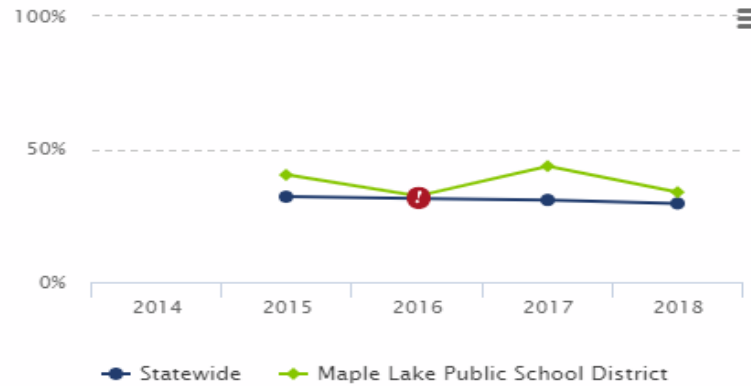

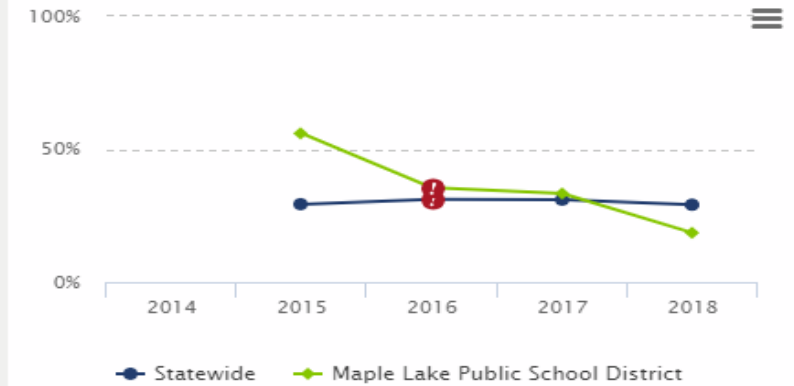

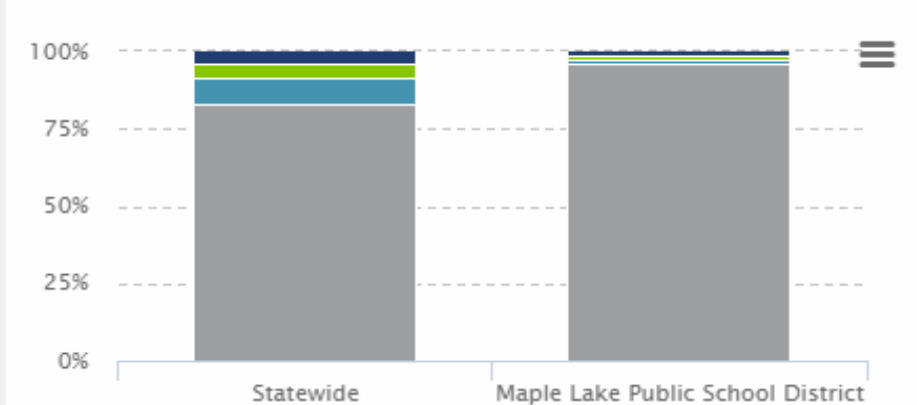

Students in the Class of 2017 and graduating in 2017



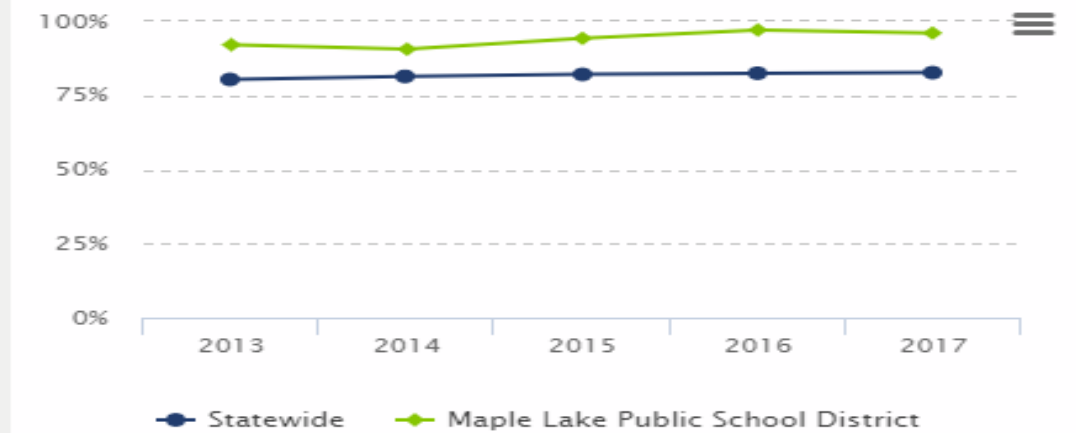
